## Terms & Conditions Of Use For Mobile Wall

The British Mountaineering Council recognises that climbing and mountaineering are "activities with a danger of personal injury or death. Participants in these activities should be aware of and accept these risks and be responsible for their own actions and involvement".

1. Wolf Mountain staff can be identified by the company logo on their clothing.
2. The following safety equipment must be worn;
  - Under 18s – helmets must be worn.
  - All participants – harnesses must be worn
3. All limbs should be covered and all loose jewellery removed. Loose hair must be tied back.
4. Users are advised to warm up slowly to avoid soft tissue injuries when commencing climbing.
5. Be aware of your limits and do not exceed them.
6. If you are uncertain of how to use any equipment ask the Wolf Mountain staff for advice beforehand.
7. Dangerous practices, injuries and damaged equipment must be reported to the wall manager immediately.
8. Smoking, drinking and drug use are not allowed around the wall.
9. People under the influence of drink or drugs are not allowed to use the wall.
10. No food, drink or personal possessions are allowed within the boundaries of the activity area.
11. Wolf Mountain can accept no responsibility for users' personal possessions.
12. Equipment must not be moved or adjusted without the wall's manager's express permission.
13. Only use the wall when instructed by Wolf Mountain staff to do so.
14. Be aware of the possibility of falling climbers and equipment.  
Never stand directly below a climber.
15. Climbers must only climb when they have been clipped in by Wolf Mountain staff.
16. A deposit of £150.00 is payable when booking.
17. Cancellation of booking within thirty (30) days of event will result in full fee being payable.
